1:30 pm -- SHOTGUN START - All tournament play begins at the same time at each hole. Each group will be assigned a hole.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT: Scramble

TEE BOXES: Men play from the White Tees, Women from the Red Tees

PUTTING CONTEST: Each Golfer can participate in the PUTTING contest after they complete the 18th hole.

LONGEST DRIVE CONTEST: Longest Drive must be on the fairway – NO “in the rough” or out-of-bound drives qualify.

Men’s Longest Drive – Hole # 10

Ladies Longest Drive – Hole # 18

CLOSEST TO THE PIN CONTEST: Closest to the pin shots MUST be on the green.

Men’s Closest to the Pin – Hole # 17

Ladies Closest to the Pin – Hole # 8

The Rules of the Game for the Tournament of Champions:

Each group is assigned a hole number

All tournament play begins at the same time at each hole

The format for the tournament is a SCRAMBLE FORMAT

- Every member of each team tees off
- Team members choose the best-positioned ball shot off the tee
- Each team member then takes a shot from that position
- Play continues in this manner until the ball goes into the cup.
- The scorecard is then marked with the number of shots taken.

Each team plays 18 holes after which the scorecard is turned in to tournament officials.
